





PEARL RESOURCE CENTRE

PEARL Resource Centre is open three days a week from 10 - 3 pm in downtown Chilliwack. From June 2021 - May 2022, the "Centre" offered vulnerable women and girls a safe place to rest, to be heard, as well as have access to a hot shower, a homemade meal, and wash a load

of laundry. Staff and volunteers also helped women access community resources with referrals to shelters, clinics, medical and mental health services, recovery facilities, addictions counselling and legal aid. Staff also supported women by booking, tracking and attending appointments, and by applying for government support and ID, as well as suitable housing. Women were mentored through acceptance, by speaking the truth in love, and through our ongoing one-on-one workshops which included pre-recovery, grief and boundaries, spiritual exploration and ongoing prayer.

This past year we have seen an increase in women making steps towards change in all areas. So many have expressed gratitude that PEARL is a drug-free facility so that they can have a break from that life, if even for a day. Being at PEARL is where they say they get a glimpse of what is possible.

THERE WERE ALSO PAINFUL IMPACTS SEEN IN THE LAST YEAR:

- Increase reports of sexual violence and trafficking of women and girls
- Increase in mental health issues and psychosis among participants
- Seeing current "solutions" to addictions fail
- A lack of legislation to protect youth at risk such as the PChAD (Protection of Children Abusing Drugs) as is available in Alberta
- Lack of intermediate housing supports (housing with treatment or recovery in progress)

PEARL'S RESTORATION HOME LIFE RENEWAL PLACE

"Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom." 2 CORINTHIANS 3:17

Life Renewal Place (LRP) opened its doors in January 2022 and we welcomed our first resident that same month! LRP is a 6 - bed, 24 month restoration home for women, 19 and over, who struggle with life controlling issues, such as substance abuse, and who have a history of sexual abuse, prostitution, or sex trafficking. Women interested in the program can apply online at www.pearliferenewal.com. Life Renewal Place's first year's annual estimated budget of \$250 K has been reached due to generous donors and grants.

In March of 2022 Jessica Kaarsemaker became the Program Coordinator at Life Renewal Place, in addition to her part time role as Director Assistant, Jessica considers her role at PEARL and LRP as an immense privilege - "walking alongside women and witnessing their personal growth and goals met, as they step bravely out in faith and make courageous choices one day at a time, is nothing short of miraculous." She is humbled and in awe of what the Lord is doing in this house. In her words: "He is on the move and hope is rising in this place! I am filled with wonder and excitement for what He has in store as He continues to work and transform lives from ashes to

beauty. Everything He touches comes to life and I get to see His life-giving power at work on a daily basis."

PEARL was one of number of grateful recipients of the Reaching Home Grant held by the City of Chilliwack in 2021. This grant, in addition to other donations and grant monies, allowed PEARL to rent a home for Life Renewal Place and purchase some new furniture and household supplies. With the help of volunteers and professionals, some minor renovations were completed, followed by a deep cleaning and then a fresh coat of interior paint!



Some new flooring was supplied by Carpet One and paint was supplied by Cloverdale Paints, all at no cost to PEARL. Additionally some area churches supplied student desks, start up groceries, gas cards, and welcome gift bags. We are grateful!

The house was fully furnished and decorated to become the beautiful home it now is. Staff welcomed the first resident in January!



RENEWAL BOUTIQUE

Renewal Boutique for women, a small store front in downtown Chilliwack, is open each Friday from 12-4pm. From June 2021 – May 2022, shoppers took advantage of the donated women's brand name, quality and gently used clothing and accessories at thrifty prices. Purchases help to fund PEARL Life Renewal's work with vulnerable women. In addition to online sales, handmade freshwater pearl jewelry was also sold at the boutique. We look forward to seeing the Boutique grow in 2022/23.

Renewal Boutique is also a future social enterprise component for Life Renewal Place, where formerly exploited women will be able to gain employable skills, volunteer experience, and income.

Why I Support PEARL as a Donor

My office is located in the downtown Chilliwack core I see the various homeless people, criminal activity, as well as many women who feel prostitution is their only way of survival — whether by choice or being trafficked by others. This is very troubling to see and tears at my heartstrings so much. A number of years ago Gerry Goosen approached me about a new ministry/support venture that his wife Joan was starting up to assist women in our community of Chilliwack who were involved in prostitution, exploitation, and other issues that desperately needed help — PEARL Life Renewal Society .

I jumped on board supporting PEARL Life Renewal as I see the incredible work, passion and dedication that Gerry and his wife Joan have for this cause, as well as Joan's team of staff and volunteers that help these women and families in our community. I see the efforts, the personal financial sacrifices that Joan and Gerry do for this cause, and it makes me want to do more to help out financially. why I serve AS VOLUNTEER

Why I volunteer at PEARL

My first introduction to PEARL was at a Sunday morning church service. A special speaker came to share about what PEARL was all about and how it got started on the Northside of Chilliwack. It was a shock to learn that this happens in our small little Bible-belt town, that these women truly exist, and human traffickers could be our next-door neighbor. I felt a tug in my heart to help these women...these women that Jesus was friends with... He sought out these women, to preach His Love, to show Love and to be Love to humanity. He was ridiculed for it... mocked and challenged... but Jesus defended them... "He who is without sin, cast the first stone." It was after a lot of prayer and bible reading that God gave me my answer with this verse.... "Each of you should use whatever gifts you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms. If anyone speaks, they should do so as one who speaks the very words of God. If anyone serves, they should do so with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ" (1 Peter 4: 10-11).

The only way I could teach my children about the love of Jesus was to get out of my comfort zone and simply serve... no matter what the serving would be.

Life circumstances opened the door of opportunity for me to become involved with PEARL and it has challenged me to become stronger in my walk with God, to practice what the true nonjudgmental love of Jesus looks like and to show Grace repeatedly. It has taught me that the blood of Jesus is unending, that we can never fall out of His love or favor, that a soul can be saved through one prayer. We have one life to make it count, to reach the broken souls, to put others above our own comforts, to pray, to minister, and to be a small light in the darkness. One person's worth is invaluable, and if I only reach one, then it was worth it all.

"Being homeless for the first time in my life, I was scared and had no idea what to do or where to turn for help. I am so glad that I reached out to Pearl Life Renewal Society, as they helped me in so many ways. Honestly, I don't know what I would have done without their support and guidance. With your ongoing support and the gracious provision of our good God, the program at Life Renewal Place will help women to renew their lives, to become survivor leaders and give back to their communities!


